Room-specific guidelines for use as a Family Room

Use of the room is subject to the terms of use for Family Rooms at Saarland University (link), which are displayed in the room. By booking the room or accepting the room key/key card, authorised users and carers are deemed to have fully accepted the terms of use, either at the time of booking or upon entering the Family Room.

Location

Building C6 2. room 1.02

Authorised users

Students and members of Saarland University. A maximum of two adults (at least one parent or guardian and one other person) and up to two children can use the room at any one time. The room is also available for individuals to use as a quiet study space in exceptional circumstances.

Equipment

The parent-and-child office is located on the first floor of the NTNM library, near a passenger lift. In this quiet space, your child can relax on a beanbag and enjoy our collection of multilingual children's books. Alternatively, they can express their creativity by using the large colouring board, coloured pencils, paper and scissors. The height-adjustable furniture and blinds that can darken the room make it a versatile space.

There is a nappy-changing facility in the first-aid room for people with restricted mobility in the basement of the building.

Access

To use the parent-child Office, you must be a registered NTNM Library user and agree to the terms of use. Library staff will unlock the room for you when you arrive and lock it again at the end of your visit.
